Founded in May 2009, Lucky Dog Animal Rescue (Lucky Dog) is an all-breed animal rescue that saves homeless and abandoned animals from certain euthanasia. Volunteer-powered, Lucky Dog rescues and rehomes approximately 2,500 at risk dogs and cats annually. Lucky Dog also serves as a critical resource for pet owners to learn about pet ownership and find companionship.

- Since 2009, Lucky Dog has saved more than 27,500 at risk dogs and cats.
- More than 2,000 volunteers support the Lucky Dog mission and operations.
- Lucky Dog is a foster home-based animal rescue with no shelter facility of its own.
- Lucky Dog is a volunteer-powered organization, with both remote and in person volunteer opportunities. We believe there is a volunteer role for everyone.
- Lucky Dog is dependent on the funding support of our donors, partners, and sponsors. Lucky Dog does not receive any state or federal funding and 100% of donor dated funds go directly to the rescue and rehoming of our dogs and cats.
- Lucky Dog rescues at risk dogs and cats from high-kill shelters in Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Mississippi, Texas, Tennessee, Georgia, West Virginia, Hawaii and Puerto Rico.
